The "Hearth" of the



MIT Center for Constructive Conversation <a href="https://www.ccc.mit.edu/">https://www.ccc.mit.edu/</a> is impressive. (See photo above: it's the round yellow and gray thing on the table.) It has 8 microphones that listen to a conversation and then takes what it hears and posts issues and allows you to click on a issue mentioned and see and hear the person speaking.

It was used in Madison, WI to listen to what people wanted in a new police chief. The Local Voices Network organized this. Go to this link <a href="https://lvn.org/PFC">https://lvn.org/PFC</a>, and scroll down a little to hear a two minute audio clip of some of the "unheard voices" to see how this works.

I am working with Dunk The Vote <a href="https://dunkthevote4ever.org/">https://dunkthevote4ever.org/</a> in Boston to see how it can be used to listen to the voices of those not normally heard by government and in elections.


